**IN THE YEAR TWO THOUSAND AND FOUR
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO
TRANSIENT VENDORS IN THE CITY OF LYNN**

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Lynn and by the authority of the same as follows to wit:-

SECTION 1:00 Christmas Trees, Wreaths and Decorations Sold on a Seasonal Basis

Every transient vendor, who sells Christmas trees, Christmas wreaths and/or Christmas decorations, on seasonal basis shall apply to the City Council for a license, and shall accompany any such application with a fee of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. Thereupon, the City Council shall authorize the City Clerk to issue a license to the applicant, authorizing the sale of Christmas trees, Christmas wreaths and/or Christmas decorations, which license shall remain in force until the first day of January following its date. All open-air stands shall be subject to Council approval in accordance with Section 4 & 12 of the Zone Ordinances of the City of Lynn. Each license shall be used at only one location at a time by said licensee, and no copies of licenses are to be made for use by any other persons.

SECTION 2:00 State license required – Display of license

- A. No license shall be granted under this ordinance until the applicant has complied with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 101, Section 3, and has exhibited to the City Clerk a license.
- B. Any license who fails, neglects or refuses to exhibit a license granted under the provisions of this chapter and applicable Massachusetts General Laws when the same is demanded to be displayed by the Sealer of Weights and Measures, agents of the Health Department or a police officer shall be subject to the same penalty as if the person had no license, as found in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 101, Sections 9 and 32.
