

Resident Rate for the Lynn Transfer Station

There has been a rate established for the resident's use of the Lynn Transfer Station from surrounding communities for the disposal of municipal solid waste (MSW). The rate will be effective on November 3, 2008 and residents must provide identification indicating which community they reside. The rate is \$0.10 per pound with no minimum charge for such customers. Payment is by credit card only no checks or cash is accepted at the transfer station. Commercial customers are exempt from this rate.

Acceptable items are listed below:

Large metal items such as washers, dryers, stoves water heaters, furniture, household items, microwaves, scrap metal, storm doors, toilets, sinks, wooden doors/decks/fencing/shingles/lumber etc., gutters, lawn mowers with gas & oil removed, carpeting and bicycles.

Only latex paint in solid form in open containers may be received.

Large items that require additional charges such as refrigerators/freezers and dehumidifiers (CFC's need to be removed charge covers management of appliance) \$25.

Mattress or box springs \$25 per item.

Unacceptable items are listed below:

No items identified by the Massachusetts DEP as "Waste Ban Items" or items considered to be "Hazardous Waste" by the Federal government or the State of Massachusetts are acceptable.

No propane tanks or yard waste.

No paints, other than solid latex paint, in liquid form.

The above list is not all inclusive but is intended as a guideline for acceptable and unacceptable items considered for disposal at the transfer station.

Individuals who leave items at the facility improperly (dumped at the gate or other location at the site) will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
