

Construction and Demolition Debris

This category generally includes asphalt, bricks, concrete (AMB) and other masonry materials, soil, rock, wall coverings, drywall, plumbing fixtures, insulation, roofing shingles, plate glass, metal, wood waste and electrical wires.

For pickup at home, call a contractor. Look in the Yellow Pages of the Telephone Book under "Rubbish & Garbage Removal". If you want to take care of the removal yourself, some options follow.

As referenced in the Lynn Recycling and Trash Information Calendar, for the convenience of the community, the DPW will offer the following services to accommodate your clean-up needs:

“DUMPSTER DAY”

Bi-annually (Fall and Spring). If you plan on doing some cleaning and want to dispose of large items, the DPW sponsors (2) Dumpster Days each year. You can also dispose of your materials at the DPW, 250 Commercial Street, Lynn, (off the Lynnway)

7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. No appliances and no contractors.

“FLOURESCENT LIGHT BULB COLLECTION”

Bi-annually (Fall and Spring). You can drop off your old fluorescent light bulbs at the DPW, 250 Commercial Street, Lynn, (off the Lynnway) from 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. There is no charge for this service.

“LEAF AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION”

Leaf and yard waste may be dropped off at 250 Commercial Street, Lynn, (off the Lynnway) every Saturday from April 1 to December 31st from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. You may also place yard waste curbside on your regular trash day by 7:00 a.m. Leaves, grass and other easily raked materials should be placed in barrels or paper leaf bags. (No stumps, rocks or plastic bags allowed).

“COMPUTER MONITORS, TV’S PROPANE TANKS COLLECTION”

Computer monitors, TV’s and propane tanks can be dropped off at the DPW, 250 Commercial Street, Lynn (off the Lynnway) every Tuesday from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. There is a \$10 charge for monitors and a \$5 charge for propane tanks.

OTHER RESOURCES

The Building Materials Resource Center (BMRC) in Roxbury accepts donations of reusable building material and house fixtures. They can provide pick-up service with at least two weeks notice or you can bring to them. Call or go to the website for more details: (617) 442-8917, www.bostonbmrc.org. Types of items collected are kitchen cabinets, countertops, bathroom vanities, sinks, faucets, tubs and enclosures, windows (no lead paint), doors (interior, exterior, storm) dimensional lumber, moldings, plywood and sheet rock (full sheets), flooring (hard wood, sheet vinyl, ceramic tile), carpeting and carpet tiles, electrical light fixtures and electrical equipment. The Center distributes these goods to needy homeowners and nonprofit organizations. Donated items are tax-deductible.
